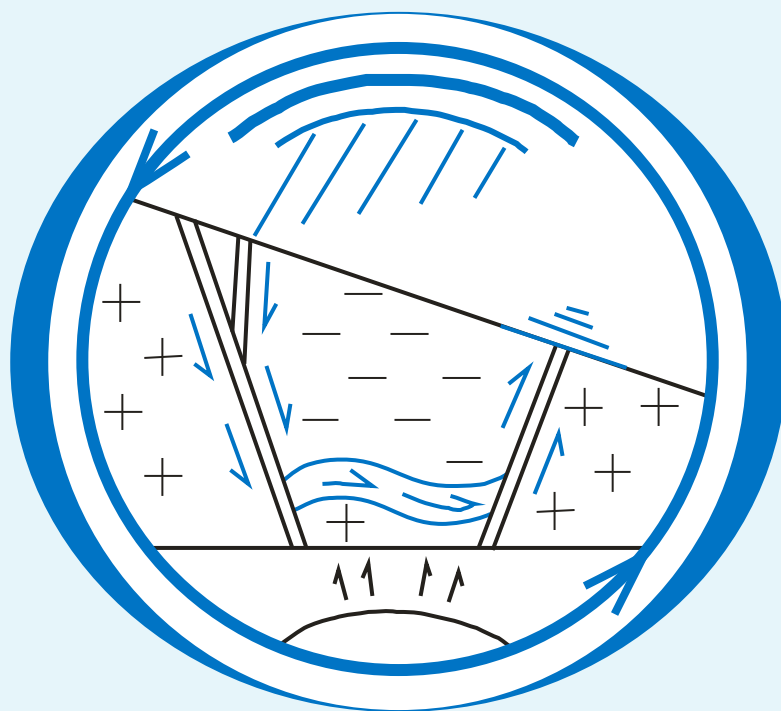

11. Geochemistry of landscapes, soils and organic matter.

### **Venue**

The center of activity for the Conference will be campus of Far Eastern Federal University (FEFU) on the Russian Island, Vladivostok. This area will be the site of the lecture halls, registration desk, poster displays, teas/coffees, and the conferees' accommodation in the campus hotel.

### **Excursion**

A post-conference field trip around interesting hydrogeological objects of Primorye is in the planning process.

### **Registration fees**

The registration fee is fixed as **100 \$ for all participants except students and postgraduates (free of charge)** and will cover the cost of the conference kit (a volume of the proceedings of the conference, a folder, a notebook, a ballpoint pen, a pin, others) and tea breaks during the sessions.

### **Report formatting:**

**Body of the report** should contain introduction, objects and methods, results of study and discussion, conclusion and references. The text shouldn't exceed 4 pages (invited papers - up to 8 pages) together with illustrations and references. It should be arranged in two-column format in accordance with the following parameters: text editor - Microsoft Word 2003 or 2007, font size - 12 pt, in Times New Roman, vertical spacing – 1, all borders – 15 mm, the first line of the paragraph - without the indent, justification - across the width of the page.

**Report title** is to be typed in Times New Roman bold letters, font size -12 pt, left justification. Skip one line lower there must be the author's surname with initials, printed in Times New Roman bold letters, 11 pt font size. Next line should contain full organization name (abbreviation is not allowed), city, country, and the e-mail in italics, in Times New Roman, 10 pt font size. Abstract should start in a line with a required forward word ABSTRACT in capital letters. Abstract in Russian and English should not be longer than 50-100 words, in Times New Roman, 10 pt font size, and justified across the width. Text body should begin after one line skip.

**Figures and Tables** will be accepted in black-and-white format, A4 size maximum. In the text, they must immediately follow their citations written in parentheses: (Fig.1), (Tabl. 2). Figures should be accompanied with captions below, and tables – with titles above and contain "Table 1." and "Figure 1." words. In case of formulas, use Equation Editor to insert into the text.

**References** should follow the body of the report after one line skip and be titled with the word REFERENCES, printed in Times New Roman, 12 pt font size. Across the text, citations to references are to be written in square brackets with the reference number inside, such as [1]. List of references (in Times New Roman, 10 pt font size) is to be arranged in alphabetical order starting from the Russian ones and not exceed 7 numbers.

The files with contributing materials are required to be named according to the following order: surname, lower dash, type of material (for example: Ivanov\_text.doc, or Ivanov\_fig1.jpg, and so on).
